<b>Part C. Goals &amp; Outcomes</b>				
Applicant clearly conveyed goals and projected outcomes of the project and how identified needs will be met.	15 (please score between 0-15)			
<b>Part D. Measurement &amp; Evaluation</b>				
Applicant laid out a plan or timeline for implementation, assessment and evaluation. Specific measurements and data will be used to determine if each goal has been met and what students have learned.	15 (please score between 0-15)			
<b>Part E. Sustainability &amp; Long Term Strategy</b>
