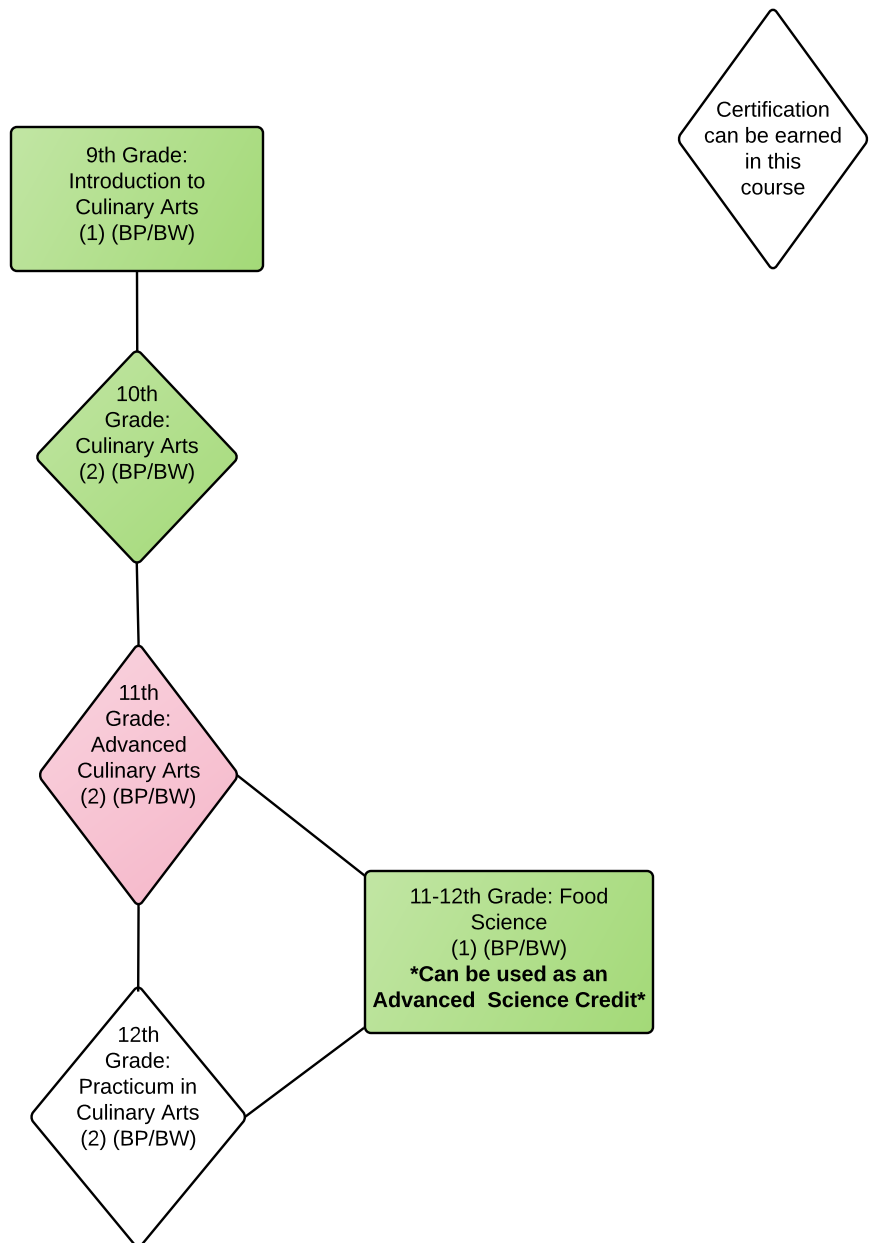


Hospitality & Tourism

This industry cluster focuses on careers in the management, operations and marketing of restaurants, other food services, lodging, attractions, recreation events and travel-related services. One of the fastest growing industries, students choosing a career in this industry sector are eligible for positions throughout the world, with potential for advancement and ready availability for continuing employment. These careers require educational preparation ranging from high school education to four-year and advanced degrees.

Apprenticeship and internship programs and technical schools play a large role in educating for these careers. The level and type of education required depends on the level and type of job responsibilities. Many positions prefer, and some require, certification. This sector encompasses three distinct yet related pathways: Food Science, Dietetics and Nutrition; Food Service and Hospitality; and Hospitality, Tourism and Recreation.
